What are the highlights of the program?

· Lean Start Up program with a U.S. Professor of Business & Entrepreneurship.

 \cdot Overview of business, economics & the entrepreneurship ecosystem in Slovenia through expert lectures and site visits.

 \cdot Internship with a top AmCham Slovenia member company and maybe even some Slovenian start-up companies.

 \cdot A peer-to-peer network with students from different universities and fields of study.



 \cdot Seeing what it takes to become an entrepreneur in Slovenia.

 \cdot Coming up with an innovative business concept and learning to make a business pitch.

 \cdot Learning about possibilities for work, study and research in the USA.

What is SEI?

The 11th Annual Student Entrepreneurship and Internship (SEI) 2022 program aims to give Slovenian university students a US-style hands-on introduction to business and economics in the real world, as well as the tools to create new businesses – the foundation of entrepreneurship.

The SEI 2022 student program is a highly selective program giving 20 students the opportunity to intern with AmCham Slovenia member companies as well as providing students with an overview of business, economics and entrepreneurship organized by the U.S. Embassy Ljubljana through a two-week Lean Start Up program with a US Professor of Entrepreneurship including over 20 targeted seminars, site visits and invited speakers.

Who organizes it?

The program is jointly organized by the US Embassy Ljubljana and AmCham Slovenia. It is funded in part by the US Embassy Ljubljana and in part by AmCham Heroes.

Am I eligible?

The program and internships are open to Slovenian citizens aged 19-28 who are 2nd year and higher undergraduate (dodiplomski) or Master's degree students enrolled in faculties preferably at Slovenian universities.

STUDENTS FROM ALL FIELDS OF STUDY ARE ENCOURAGED TO APPLY.

We actually prefer students <u>without</u> a background in economics or business and we particularly encourage students in the natural sciences, engineering, math, computer science/IT and medicine to apply!



Applicants must be:

 \cdot 2nd year and higher undergraduate (dodiplomski) or Master's degree students (up to age 28) in good standing.

 \cdot able to read, write and speak English at a high level.

How many people are in the program?

Twenty (20) students will be selected.

Where does the program take place?

The two-week SEI program will take place in Ljubljana, Slovenia.

Internships will take place at AmCham Slovenia member companies or Slovenian start-ups, largely in Ljubljana.

Will I get an internship? Is the internship paid?

Every student will be invited to participate in an SEI 2022 internship. The application form will ask you to specify fields of interest. At the SEI 2022 interview, students will be asked to name up to three AmCham Slovenia member companies where they would like to intern. Although we cannot guarantee an internship at the companies you choose, we will do our best to find you a great match, possibly even at a Slovenian start-up with the help of U.S. Embassy Ljubljana!

These internships are <u>paid</u>; companies are advised to pay at least the minimum hourly rate for students.

Do I have to pay for the SEI program?

The two-week SEI program is free for the 20 selected students!

When does the program start?

July 11-22, 2022: U.S. Embassy organized – US Professor of Entrepreneurship Lean Start Up program and overview of business, economics & the entrepreneurship ecosystem in Slovenia through 20+ expert lectures, seminars and site visits.

May-September: Flexible one-month internships with AmCham Slovenia companies and some Slovenian start-ups (128 hours ~1 month)

What do you need from me?



- · Student Application form
- · University transcript
- · 1-minute video pitch
- · Recent photo in .jpg format

Dates & Deadlines

- The application deadline is Friday, March 11, 2022.
- · Interviews for top applicants will be held in mid-March either live or via ZOOM.
- · Students will be notified of acceptance by the end of March 2022 at the latest.
